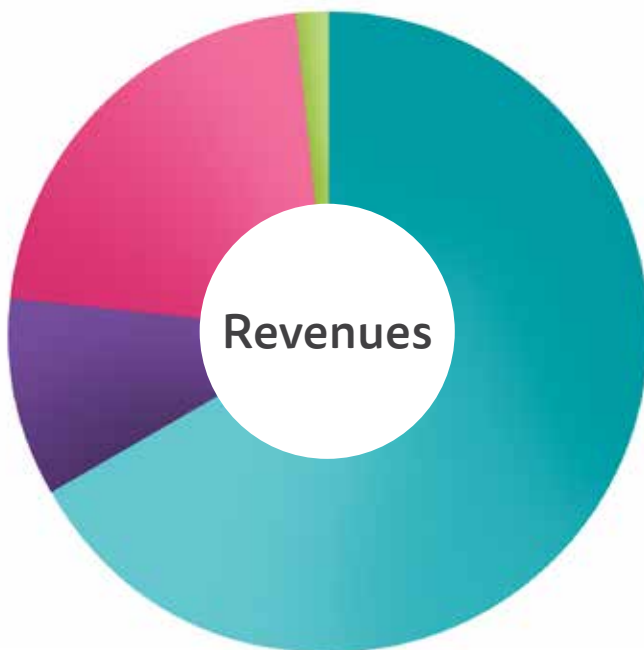

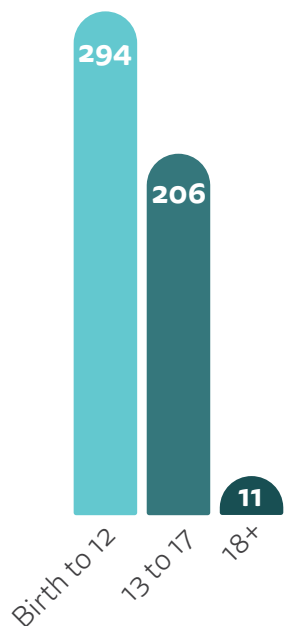

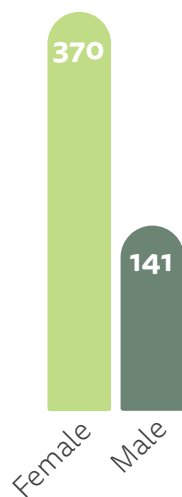

Our Children's Advocacy Centers provide a safe, supportive environment in which children who have been physically or sexually abused or have witnessed a violent act can be interviewed and examined.

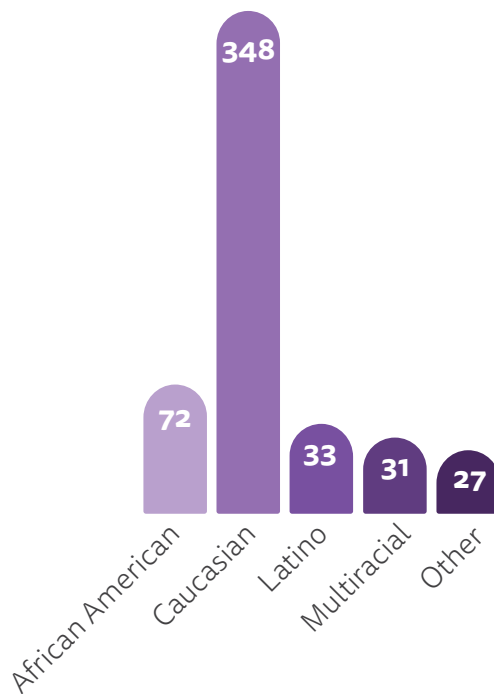
Age of victim



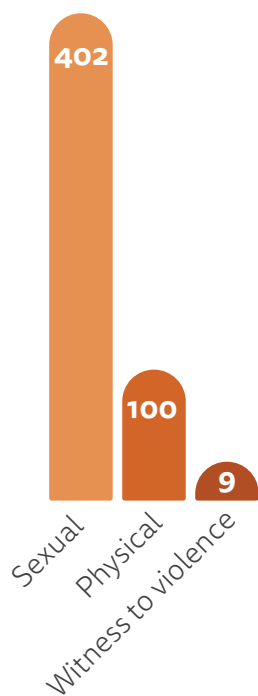
Gender of victim



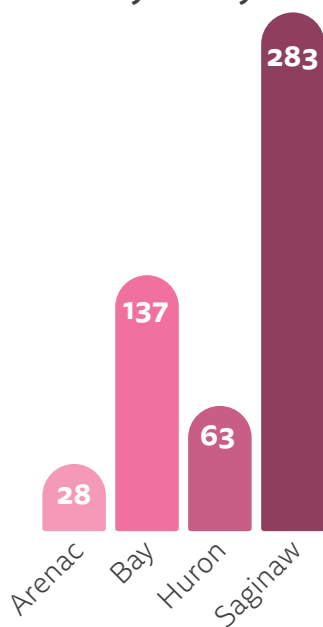
Ethnicity of victim

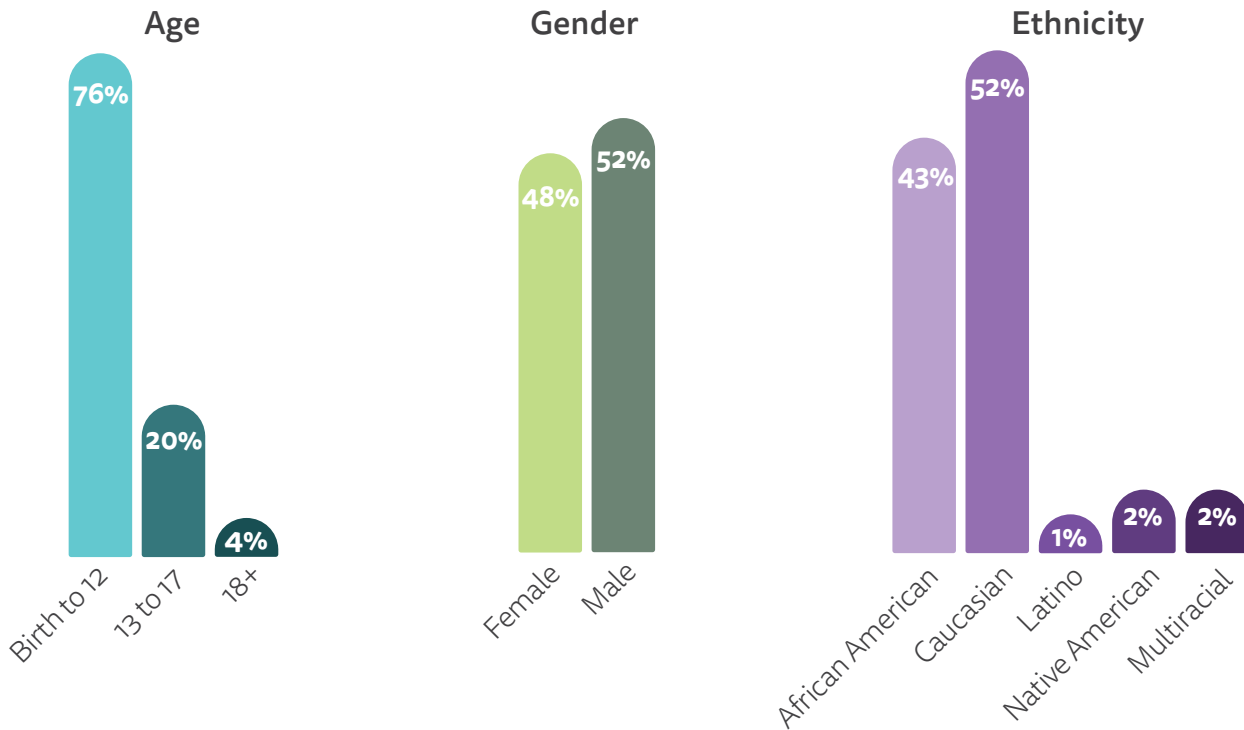

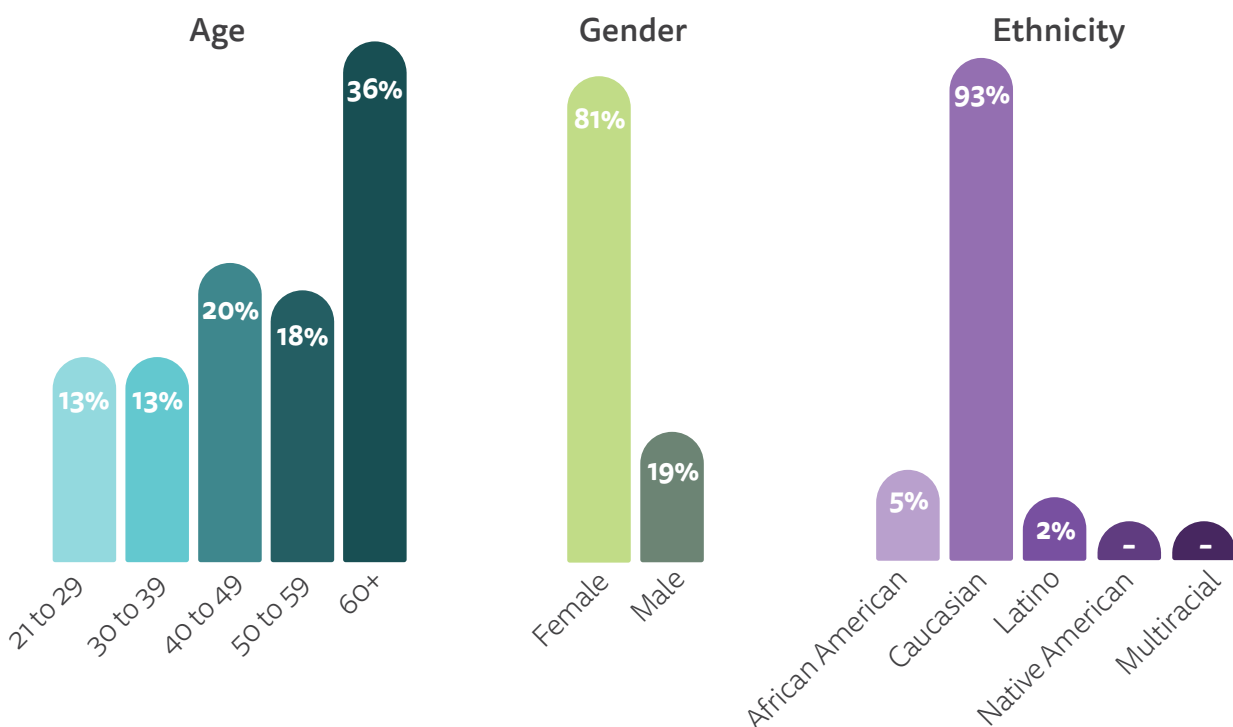

Often times, the children for whom our CASA volunteers advocate have had very few consistent adults in their lives. The volunteers may experience difficulty connecting and building relationships with these children who have found themselves in challenging – and perhaps perilous – circumstances. Sometimes a CASA might even feel like their weekly visits aren’t having the impact they were hoping for.

But often, after months of visits and wondering whether they’re making a difference, a CASA will witness a seemingly small but truly extraordinary moment in which a child can just be a child – even during what’s likely to be the most difficult journey they’ll ever endure.

Don Wilson – who has been a CASA volunteer since 2019 and has advocated for four children – knows firsthand the rewarding triumph of those extraordinary moments that can take months to build toward.

Don’s first case had come to the court’s attention multiple times. The children he was assigned had experienced domestic violence in their home for years. Their lives were chaotic and unpredictable. They did not have many stable people in their lives.

Visiting the children weekly, Don started building a relationship with them. But one was more difficult to connect with than the others. It took several months, but one day, Don suddenly had a breakthrough with her.

“She was difficult to communicate with, but at one particular visit – about eight months into the case – she was telling me about something that happened at school. It was a fun event. The more she talked about it, she just lit up! She was smiling and laughing,” he recalls. “And it hit me: This was the first time in knowing this girl for eight months that I’d ever seen her smile.”

That moment with that girl made Don see serving as a CASA in a whole new light.

“The impact you might have might just be that two minutes you get a child to smile and laugh and forget about all the difficulties they’re dealing with in their life,” he says.

And because of the dedication of CASA volunteers like Don, dozens of local children each year don’t have to face those difficulties alone. ●

Participant says Make Parenting a Pleasure ‘may have brought me back from the dead’

Parent Support Programs are a staple of our CAPE programming, providing free classes and workshops that teach parenting skills and provide opportunities for parents to learn and grow together in a mutually supportive environment.

A desire to become a better parent and to demonstrate to the court that she was serious about her role as a parent sent Stephanie on a search for Saginaw-based parenting resources in 2021. That’s when she found the CAN Council and our Make Parenting a Pleasure class – a research- and evidence-based group curriculum for parents of children ages birth to 8 that also features collaborations with community partners.

After enrolling in the class – which she refers to as being “heaven sent” – Stephanie quickly knew she’d found what she was looking for.

“I learned that other parents struggled just like me and that the class leaders did not cast one ounce of judgment on the members of this class,” she says. “Whatever reason we showed up to this class, it was clear to me that the class leaders were there to guide us and give us help on parenting – from learning how to deal with our temperament as a parent to our child’s temperament, along with how to use your child’s outbursts to learn about your child and how you can communicate positively.”



Stephanie, now 38, opted to take the class a second time “because I feel a connection to the other parents and the class leaders, because overall on some level, we can relate to dealing with a child who is just not having a good day.” She says the knowledge, skills and support she gained from the class have been life-altering.

“My daughter and I have a better connection and communication because of this class. And her dad and I have had better communication while I have been in this class,” she says. “Because once a week, I am reminded how a good, stable parent can be and the benefits from it, and I took that information and went running with it. And my life and my child’s life have improved so much.”

Stephanie says her daughter’s father is allowing her to see her daughter for the first time in several years – and in her mind, it’s no secret as to what has changed.

“I really feel that this class had something to do with it. It taught my brain to change the way I look at being a parent. I had support I didn’t have before. I had understanding from people I didn’t have before,” she says. “This program has impacted my life so much it brings a tear to my eye. It may have brought me back from the dead. I had almost given up. Had I not found this class, I really don’t know where I would be on my journey. I thank the team at CAN Council for forever impacting me and my way of parenting.” ●

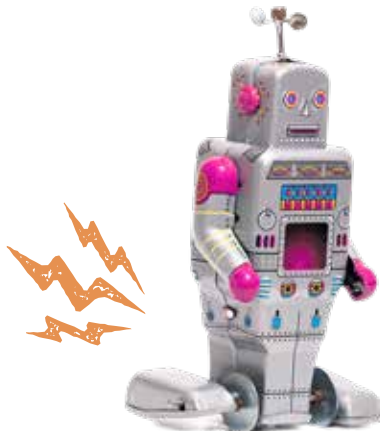
